**NOTICE OF CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**  
**FIRST PEOPLES OF THE MILLEWA-MALLEE NATIVE TITLE CLAIM**

**PURPOSE**

The Federal Court has ordered that the Judicial Registrar holds a case management conference (**CMC**) in Mildura to explain where the First Peoples of the Millewa-Mallee (**FPMM**) claim is up to, what decisions the claim group needs to make now, and the issues that may arise depending on the outcome of the claim group authorisation meeting, which is scheduled for 11 May 2025. The court orders are **enclosed**.

A case management conference is an official court event designed to facilitate the resolution of court matters as quickly and efficiently as possible. **The CMC will be run by Judicial Registrar Daniel and is an opportunity for the claim group to discuss the claim with the court directly.** The FPMM claim lawyers will also be present.
